SUBJECT: Annual Re-Notification Required by AHERA

The Midland Park Board of Education has contracted with Environmental Remediation & Management Inc. to act as their “Designated Person” as defined under the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) of 1986. AHERA requires that all educational facilities be inspected for asbestos – containing materials and develop a remedial plan of action on or before May 9, 1989. In addition, each educational facility shall reassess all identified asbestos – containing materials, or materials assumed to be asbestos, at least once every six months (periodic –containing materials, or materials assumed to be asbestos, at least once every six months (periodic surveillance), and re-inspect those facilities every three years.

The Midland Park Board of Education is in compliance with these requirements. The most recent Tri-annual re-inspection was performed in October, 2012, with the next one scheduled for October, 2015. “Periodic Surveillance” inspections are performed every April and October, with the next one scheduled for April, 2016.

Following each inspection, appropriate remedial actions are recommended to the Board of Education by an accredited Asbestos Management Planner. The remedial plans of action and recommended schedules for implementation (Asbestos Management Plans) are available for review at the Midland Park Board of Education Administrative office, as well as in each school office.

We will continue to keep you informed of our AHERA compliance.
